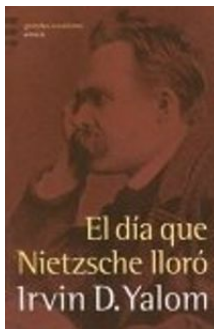


EL DÍA QUE NIETZSCHE LLORÓ
