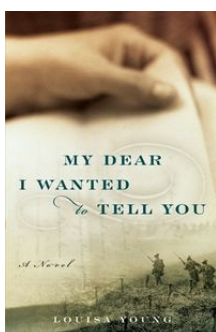


MY DEAR I WANTED TO TELL YOU
